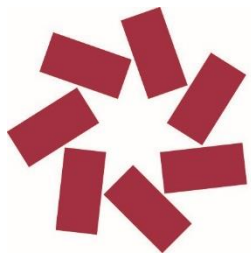

- Open: Monday 5th August 2019
- Close: Monday 2nd September 2019 @ 8pm WA time.

- Senior Class - \$95.00
- Secondary Senior Classes - \$75.00
- Junior Class - \$75.00
- Rookies/Midgets - \$20.00 (Demonstration Only)

Online nominations are the only method for nominating for all classes except Midgets & Rookies.

Entrant Eligibility:

As Per Rules 1 & 2 Appendix "A" of the 2019 AIDKA Rule Book:

1. To compete in a class, you must have the appropriate Licence grade or higher for that class. All drivers nominating for a title event must have completed a minimum of three (3) CLUB meetings in the 12 months preceding close of nominations of that Title event, in that grade to be eligible to run a title event. Endorsed or Probationary drivers will need three (3) ROF and three (3) in the field (total of six (6) race meetings) before the close of nominations.

LICENCE GRADES: AS PER RULE: 5.2.1.

2. Nominations shall only be accepted as per the prospectus with any requested information and the appropriate fees. The nomination forms, payment and copy of drivers log book must be received by A.I.D.K.A. so that all nominations can be verified and acceptance granted. A.I.D.K.A. will notify the host club of the status of nominations.

Refund Policy: Any nomination cancelled before close of nomination will incur a 50% fee. Cancellations after closing will result in a loss of nomination fee. The only exemption are cancellations due to a valid medical reason (certificate required) these cancellations will receive a full refund.





Drugs and alcohol:

Drug and alcohol testing may be carried out at random over the course of the Title Event on any given day or time, as per the AIDKA Drug and Alcohol Policy, located on the AIDKA website.

Scales:

Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day, as per AIDKA rule 10.8 of the 2019 AIDKA Rule Book.

Fuel testing:

As per Appendix "B" of the 2019 AIDKA Rule Book.

Registration & scrutineering:

- At the driver registration on Friday you will be required to sign in.
- Here you will be issued with an armband, where you will sign the indemnity sheet, have your log book signed. If you haven't pre-printed a scrutineering form you will be able to get one at registration desk where you will be issued your chassis and engine seals. You will sign for your seals at this point.
- You will require an engine seal for the engine you will be running. If you require an additional seal for your spare, these will be available from the scrutineer during the meeting. Any engine sealed must be presented with the seal still attached for engine measuring at the completion of the meeting.
- You will also require a chassis seal if your chassis does not have a chassis number stamped into it.
- AIDKA seals intact from previous titles may be reused.
- Once you have your seals and self-scrutineering form you are required to complete the form. Please ensure that you have entered the correct seal numbers in the correct space. Do not mix up the engine & chassis seals and make sure the form is signed at the bottom.
- When your class is called up for practise, you will be requested to bring up the completed self-scrutineering form and hand it to the official on the out grid before you proceed. If you are not participating in practice you must bring your form up at the time of your first heat.
ALL FORMS MUST BE HANDED IN BEFORE THE START OF RACING.
- **Seals must be fitted prior to the first heat of racing.**
- Random checks will be performed on karts during the meeting. Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart can enter the track or be excluded from starting the race.
- If you have any questions regarding technical requirements you can ask an official who will direct you to the appropriate person.

MORE THAN TROPHIES

Racing numbers:

- As per Rule 33 Appendix "A" of the 2019 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing number in a class,
 - First preference goes to the Jennacubbine member;
 - Second preference to the driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number.
- Current Australian and State Title plates are permitted to be used.
- The allocated number will be issued by the AIDKA Secretary and advised via the AIDKA website after close of nominations if nominated number needs to be changed.
- Racing numbers must comply with rule 15.17.1 through to rule 15.17.14 inclusive. Please refer to the images available on the AIDKA website.

Pit area access:

Only AIDKA licenced persons are permitted in the pit area.

All other persons must purchase a Casual Pit Pass & wear enclosed shoes before entering the pit area.

The following options are available:

ONE DAY Pit Pass = \$ 5.00 TWO DAY Pit Pass = \$ 10.00 THREE DAY Pit Pass = \$ 15.00

If the weekend wrist band is removed prior to the end of the State Title Event, a new Pit Pass must be purchased.

WRIST BANDS AND ENCLOSED FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILST IN THE DESIGNATED PIT AREA.

PLEASE NOTE:

Children under 5 and adults over 90 are not covered by AIDKA Insurance, therefore enter to the pit area is at their own, or parent/guardian's risk. Under 5's and over 90's will need to register, sign a waiver and wear a wrist band that shows they have done so before entry to the pit area.

PIT AREA RULES:

- Smoking is not permitted in the Pit Area at any time. Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking areas.
- Alcohol is NOT TO BE CONSUMED or located in the pit area at any time.



Pit Allocation:

- There will be allocated pit bays.
- If racing only one kart, please pit from your own marquee. If using two or more karts, please notify club if you wish to pit from trailer. If no notification then the assumption is that you be pitting from your marquee. If you have a large marquee, please advise dimensions via email to Norm.
- Please **email** Norm if you wish to pit from your trailer or wish to pit next to someone else. nkc69@westnet.com.au
- Trailers can be dropped off on Thursday afternoon and gates will be open from 12pm.
** Please note: You will be doing this at your own risk as there is no security at the track after hours.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU CLEAN UP YOUR PIT BAY AT THE END OF EACH DAY USING THE BINS AROUND THE PIT AREA. Fines may apply if not adhered to.

Racing Format:

Friday 4th October 2019

- Driver Sign-In
- Practice – 4 laps each way

Saturday 5th October 2019

- Kart Tuning (2 hot laps) straight into Heat 1(6 laps)
- Heats 2 & 3 (6 laps)
- Midget Demonstrations at discretion of Chief Steward (6 laps but subject to change)

Sunday 6th October 2019

- Heat 4 (6 laps) & final (8 laps)
- Rookies Demonstrations at discretion of Chief Steward (6 laps but subject to change)

Presentation Dinner:

- Venue: Jennacubbine Hall
- Adults - \$35 per Person
- Children - \$20 per Child, 14 years and under
- Paid at time of nominating. Tickets distributed at Driver Registration.





Points system:

- Quick Grid to be used to calculate placing's and grid draw
- Final positions to be contested over 4 heats and a final.

DIRECTIONS FROM PERTH:

You can type in Jennacubbine into your maps and it will lead you straight to the track.

However here are the directions:

Get on to Great Eastern Highway, follow for about 80km

Turn right at the Goomalling exit

Turn left onto Northam-Pithara road

Follow for around 14 kms

Turn left onto Yarramony Road

Follow for about 10kms before turning right at the cross road. (Before it turns into Tyndall Rd)

You will head past a church, then a bridge, then go over the rail way line

See Yellow arrows as to where to enter pits.
