Cancellation after close of nominations will incur a 100% cancellation fee;

ie no refund.

Only exceptions are: (a) Medical Reason – must have a G.P. letter

(b) Government enforced Covid 19 restriction that

prohibits entry to the South West region of WA.

100% refund

Pit Entry Pit entry requires a wristband. These are issued at sign in.

Unlicensed pit entry will cost \$5.00 a day

Wristbands will be available throughout the day from the canteen.

Sign-in Procedure At sign-in you will be issued wristband for pit entry.

Indemnity sheets to be signed and you'll have your log book signed.

You will also be issued your new barcode chassis and engine seal.

AIDKA Officials will record your unique seal numbers.

Engine / Chassis Seals You will require an engine seal for the engine/s you will be running.

For your spare engines, these will be made available from the scrutineer

throughout the meeting.

Engine seals to be fitted as per 2021 rule book.

New chassis seal will be issued regardless if you have a stamped chassis

number.

Chassis seals are to be fixed at the base of the steering column.

Seals must be fitted prior to the heat of racing.

It is the driver's responsibility to ensure these seals are attached correctly.

Race Numbers Race numbers as per the 2021 Rule Book.

Scrutineering Self scrutineering to be done and you acknowledge your kart complies with

AIDKA Safety rules when you do your driver sign-in.

Random scrutineering checks will be done throughout the weekend.

Any issues will need to be rectified prior to any further participation in the

event.

Format 4 Heats and Final.

8 Lap Heats.

10 Lap Final.

Right to decrease laps due to time constraints and/or track conditions if

necessary

Friday 5th November Practice and Heat 1

Practice = 3 Laps one way only with interstate drivers able to practice in

opposite direction for 3 laps.

Saturday 6th November Heats 2 and 3

Sunday 7th November Heats 4 and Final

Track will be watered and graded as deemed necessary.

Racing may be under lights Friday night.

Midgets and Rookies 5 laps only.

Scales Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day as per 2012 AIDKA rule book.
