ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRANTS: As per Rule 1, Appendix "A" of the 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

An exemption has been granted for unqualified AIDKA License Holders who reside in the Northern Territory. They will be permitted to start as non-qualifiers at the rear of the field. The qualification status will be taken at the close of nominations. (i.e. so if not qualified by the close of Noms but qualified by the time of the title they still will start rear of field)

REFUND POLICY: Any nomination cancelled before close of nominations will incur a 50% cancellation fee. Cancellations after close of

nominations will incur a 100% cancellation fee i.e.: no refund. Only exceptions are:

- Medical reason – must have GP letter. 100% refund
- Government enforced COVID-19 restriction that prohibits entry to the Alice Springs region – 100% refund

PIT ENTRY:

Pit entry requires a wristband. These are issued at sign-in. Unlicensed pit entry will cost \$5 per day. Wristbands will be available throughout the day at the Canteen.

ENGINE/CHASSIS SEALS:

Drivers will be issued with the barcoded chassis and engine seal during Driver Registrations. Drivers will only be issued the engine seal for the engine/s you will be running. If you require an additional seal for your spare engine, these will be made available from the Scrutineer during the meeting. Any engine sealed must be presented with the seal still attached for engine measuring at the completion of the meeting.

Engine seals to be fitted as per 2022 AIDKA Rulebook.

New Chassis seals will also be issued regardless of if you have a stamped chassis number. Chassis seal to be fixed to bottom of steering column.

Seals must be fitted prior to first heat of racing. It is the driver's responsibility to ensure these seals are attached correctly.

Random scrutineering checks will be performed on karts during the meeting. Any karts missing either an engine or chassis seal will need to be rectified before further racing. If any issues (i.e. unsafe kart/ missing seal) is not rectified prior to a race commencing, the offending kart may be removed from the outgrid.

If you have any questions regarding technical requirements, you can ask an official who will direct you to the right person to help.

SCRUTINEERING:

On your driver's registration/ indemnity form there is an additional column you will acknowledge your kart complies with AIDKA safety standards when you sign the indemnity & safety compliance form.

Random Scrutineering checks will be done throughout the weekend. Any issues will need to be rectified prior to any further participation in event.

FORMAT:

6 Heats - drop your worst heat

Seniors/Juniors 8 lap heats

Rookies/Midgets 5 lap heats

Laps numbers may be altered if required by the Chief Steward.

TROPHIES:

Awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places. 4-6th place ribbons will also be awarded if competing in a split field (over 20 competitors)

TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be used at this event.

Competitors must have a transponder correctly fitted before entering the track as per Rule 13.13.13 including practice.

It is the Competitors responsibility to enter the correct transponder number on their nomination at the time of entering.

FACILITIES:

Full Canteen available during the weekend

NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE CONSUMED OR TAKEN INTO PIT AREAS

Random Drug and Alcohol may be conducted at this event.
