WHAT THE FLAGS/LIGHTS MEAN



GREEN & YELLOW FLAGS/LIGHTS (crossed)

Form up the race start or restart



GREEN FLAG/LIGHTS

Race starts



YELLOW FLAG/LIGHTS

Hold position. Do not pass any karts until past the next Flag Marshall point not showing a yellow flag



BLUE FLAG/LIGHTS

Driver being lapped, hold your race line.



RED FLAG/LIGHTS

Slow down, raise hand, (acknowledge having seen flag) Pull to the side of the track in a safe (controlled) manner, **STOP**. A kart rollover will automatically bring about a red flag.



BLACK FLAG

Faulty equipment, or has broken rules of racing must leave track with caution. Board with number can be shown



RED & WHITE CHEQUERED FLAG

All karts are to return to the pits and await further instructions.



WHITE FLAG

One lap remaining



BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED FLAG

Race finished. All karts passing this flag must stop racing and slow down with caution



23 POINT SYSTEM

The WA Dirt Kart State Titles are run using the 23 point system as required by AIDKA. The points are as follows:

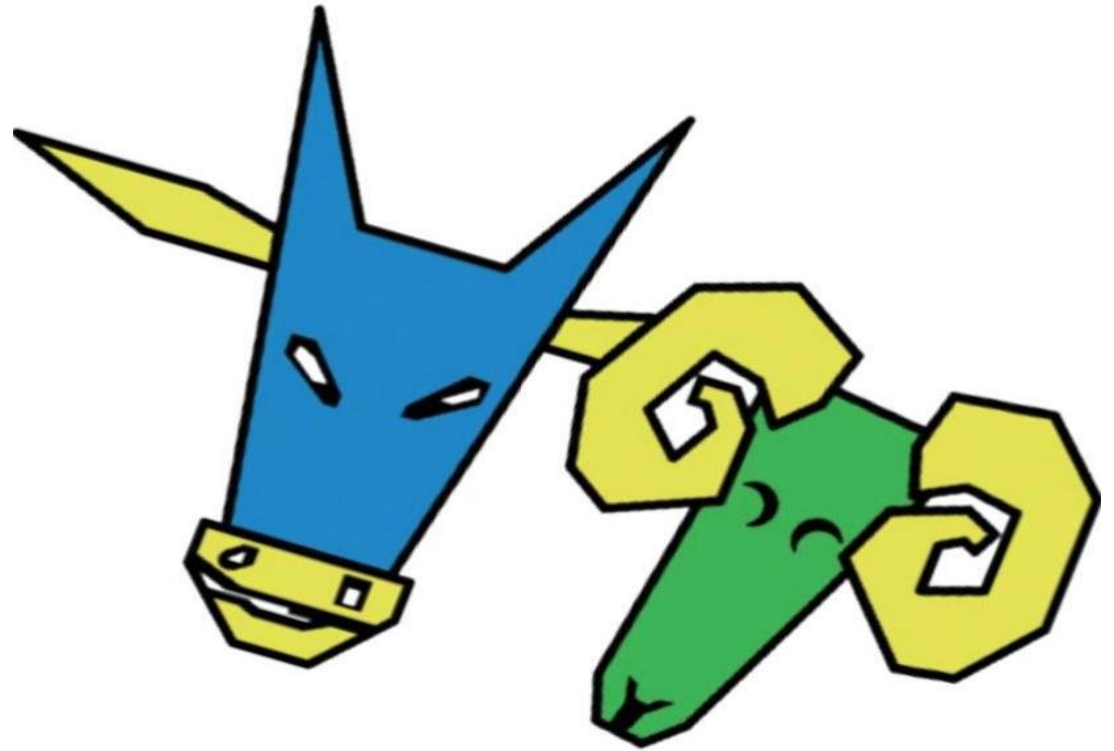
