Trophies

Quick Grid to be used to calculate grid draw and placings.

Final positions to be contested over 4 heats determining starting position in the

final.

Highest points over the 4 heats and final determines final placing.

Orbits timing software to be used in conjunction with karting compatible

transponders. Transponders are compulsory as per the 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Trophies and AIDKA Australian Title number plates will be awarded to the first

three place winners in each class.

Sashes will be awarded to drivers placed 4th to 6th only in over-subscribed

classes (more than 20 nominations with split fields).

Rookies Demonstration class may run, depending on nominations in other classes.

Only if time permits, first 20 nominations only will be accepted.

Rookies will run on Sunday only if time permits.

There is no guarantee to how many heats will be run as this class is non-

competitive.

Rookies nomination fee \$20 for Sunday.

Rookies nominations will be received via a separate event on the AIDKA App.

Drivers will receive participation awards.

Nominations close same day and time as AIDKA Title nominations or prior if

maximum 20 Rookies is reached.

Class Requirements A minimum of 8 genuine nominations constitutes a class as per 2022 AIDKA

Rule Book.

Nominations Open Sunday 17th July via the AIDKA App.

No other method of nomination will be accepted.

Nominations for Rookies to be placed via a separate event on the AIDKA App.

Nominations Close 22nd August 2022 at 9pm.

No late nominations will be accepted.

Rookies \$20

Please note: No Midgets will be demonstrating at this event.

Full payment must accompany nomination.

Entrant Eligibility As per Rules 1 and 2, Appendix A of the 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Licence Grades As per 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Nominations shall only be accepted as per the prospectus with any requested

information and the appropriate fees being paid in full.









The nomination forms, payment and copy of driver's log book must be received by AIDKA so that all nominations can be verified.

Payment Method

Full payment must accompany the nomination via the AIDKA App for your nominations to be accepted. PayPal is required to complete payment.

Confirmation of your nomination will be posted on AIDKA app.

Once AIDKA Secretary has checked and confirmed all nominations, those that need to change race numbers will be notified either by email or text.

Refund Policy

Any nomination cancelled before close of nomination will incur a 50% fee.

Cancellations after closing will result in a loss of full nomination fee.

The only exceptions are:

- Cancellations due to a valid medical reason (certificate required). These cancellations will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations due to a Government enforced COVID-19 restriction that prohibits entry to Tatiara region. These cancellations will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations by Tatiara Karting Club due to unforeseen circumstances.

Rules

As per the 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Drugs and Alcohol

Drug and alcohol testing may be carried out at random throughout Australian Dirt Kart Title event on any given day or time, as per AIDKA 2022 Rule Book.

Scales

Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day as per 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Scales are available for drivers to set up their weights from Thursday prior to event.

Weights may be re-checked before and/or after any races throughout the event.

Fuel Testing

As per the 2022 AIDKA Rule Book.

Registration & Welcome

The Tatiara Community will welcome drivers and visitors by hosting a Street Party on Thursday between 4pm and 8pm in Woolshed Street. (walking distance from track)

Driver registration will be held at this location between 4pm and 8pm.

Dinner & festivities will be available at the Street Party.

Driver registration will also be held at the Tatiara Karting Club canteen/club rooms on Friday between 6.30am and 7.30am.

You will receive a named registration bag at time of registering.









- You will require an engine seal and chassis seal for the engine & chassis you
 will be running. If you require an additional seal for your spare motor, these
 will be available from the scrutineer during the meeting. Any engine used
 must be presented with the seal still attached for the engine measuring at the
 conclusion of the race meeting.
- Seals must be fitted prior to the first heat of racing.

Scrutineering

Self scrutineering applies. Qualified scrutineers will spot check karts throughout the event.

Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart can participate in any further racing.

Any issue (ie: unsafe kart/missing seal) that is not rectified prior to a race commencing, may result in the offending kart being removed from the out grid.

Any kart missing either an engine or chassis seal that is not rectified may be excluded from the race meeting.

If you have any questions regarding technical requirements, you can ask an official who will direct you to the appropriate person.

Kart Numbers

As per 2022 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing number in a class:

First preference goes to the Tatiara Karting Club member.

Second preference goes to the driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number.

Current Australian and SA State Title Plates are permitted to be used.

The allocated number will be issued by the AIDKA Secretary and advised via the AIDKA website after close of nominations.

Racing numbers must comply with the AIDKA rule book. Please refer to the images available on the AIDKA website.

Pit Area Access & Event Access

The premises for the 2022 Aussie Dirt Kart Titles will be classified as an open Pit Area. This means an AIDKA Pit Pass is required for all persons attending the Title Event.

Event entry for unlicenced persons:

- For any persons who do not hold an AIDKA Licence a Casual Pit Pass must be purchased prior to entering the premises. Passes will only be permitted to persons wearing enclosed shoes.
- PLEASE NOTE: Children under 5 and adults over 90 are not covered by AIDKA Insurance, therefore enter the pit area at their own, or parent/guardians risk. These persons will need to sign a Casual Pit Pass, sign a waiver and wear a wrist band that shows they have done so, before entry to the pit area.
- Pit passes cost \$5 per day.

A wrist band will be issued and must be worn at the event.









If the pit pass wrist band is removed prior to the end of the Title Event, a new Pit Pass must be purchased.

Please Note – NOT PERMITTED in the Pit Area during the designated racing times are –

- Smoking (including e-cigarettes)
- Fires, camp fires, stoves, gas fridges etc
- Pets or animals
- Alcohol consumption

Designated areas will be allocated for the above where possible. Location of these areas will be shown in the program.

Pit Parking

Pits will open from Thursday 10am, all trailers MUST be in the pits NO Later than 6.30pm Thursday.

If you are unable to pit on Thursday, a 1 hour only window has been scheduled for Friday 5.30am to 6.30am. Bookings are essential to park during this time. Please email membership@tatiarakartingclub.net.au. You will be pitted at the closest convenient pit bay, there will be no priority pitting on Friday. No bays will be held for Friday entry.

The following criteria should be considered:

- Trailers are not to be removed at the end of each day/night and put back in the next day.
- Once your trailer has entered the pits, it's in for the event duration. If you need
 to remove a trailer for any reason, please see Tatiara Karting Club President,
 Vice President or Secretary for assistance. Please understand, any trailers
 removed over night and wanting to return will be repositioned closest to the
 entry gate.
- There will be no security on duty overnight.
- Trailers only to remain in the pits, all vehicles are to be removed.
- All trailers will be parked with the assistance of Pit Marshals whose directions will be final.
- Vehicles are not permitted in the pit area while racing is in progress and are not permitted until the conclusion of racing on the last day.
- If you wish to be located/pitted near another competitor, you must arrive together. Spaces will not be held.
- If you have large trailers or multiple karts arriving in a large vehicle please email details for consideration to membership@tatiarakartingclub.net.au.
- While every effort will be made to satisfy requests, no guarantees can be made, as your request may not be achievable.
