Entrant Eligibility	As per Rules 1 and 2, Appendix A as per the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book			
Licence Grades	Nominations shall only be accepted as per the prospectus with any requested information and the appropriate fees being paid in full.			
	The nomination, payment and copy of driver's log book must be received by AIDKA so that all nominations can be verified.			
	The status of the nomination will be available on the AIDKA App under Class Entries.			
Payment Method	Full payment must accompany the nomination via the AIDKA app for your nominations to be accepted. PayPal or a credit card is required to complete your online payment			
	Confirmation of your nomination will be posted on AIDKA app.			
Refund Method	Any nomination cancelled before close of nomination will incur a 50% fee. Cancellations after closing will result in a loss of full nomination fee.			
	 The only exceptions are: Cancellations due to a valid medical reason (certificate required). These cancellations will receive a full refund. 			
Rules	As per the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book			
Drugs and Alcohol	Drug and alcohol testing may be carried out at random throughout South Australian State Dirt Kart Title event on any given day or time, as per AIDKA 2023 Rule Book.			
Scales	Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day as per AIDKA 2023 Rule Book.			
	Weights may be re-checked before and/or after any races throughout the event.			
Fuel Testing	As per Rule 25 to 25.3 of the AIDKA 2023 Rule Book			

Registration	At the driver registration on Thursday between 5pm and 7pm and on Friday morning between 8am and 9am.
	 At sign-in, you will be issued with a wristband, you will sign the indemnity sheet and have your logbook filled in.
	• You will require an engine seal for the engine you will be running. If you require an additional seal for your spare motor, these will be available from appointed official during the meeting. Any engine used must be presented with the seal still attached for the engine measuring at the conclusion of the race meeting.
	• You will also require a chassis seal, regardless if your chassis has a number stamped into it. The chassis seal is to be fitted to the chassis at the base of the steering column.
	Seals must be fitted prior to the first heat of racing.
Scrutineering	Self-scrutineering will be used at this event.
	Scrutineers will conduct spot-checks on karts and safety gear during the event.
	Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart can participate in any racing.
	Any issue (i.e.: unsafe kart/missing seal) not rectified prior to a race commencing, the offending kart may be removed from the out grid.
	Any kart missing either an engine or chassis seal that is not rectified may be excluded from the race meeting.
	If you have any questions regarding technical requirements, you can ask an official who will direct you to the appropriate person.
Kart Numbers	As per 2023 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing number in a class:
	• Driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number (has had a licence for the longest period of time) has first preference for kart number
	Current Australian and Title Plates are permitted to be used.
	When nominations are closed, AIDKA will check kart numbers. Any drivers who need to change their number will be contacted via the AIDKA app.
	Racing numbers must comply with the AIDKA rule book. Please refer to the images available on the AIDKA website.
Pit Area Access	Only AIDKA licenced persons are permitted in the pit area.
	All other persons must purchase a Casual Pit Pass and be wearing enclosed shoes before entering the pit area. Casual Pit passes are available online via the AIDKA app from the date nominations open, until the completion of the event.
	If the pit pass wrist band is removed prior to the end of the Title Event, a new Pit Pass must be purchased.
	WRIST BANDS AND ENCLOSED FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILST IN THE DESIGNATED PIT AREA
	PLEASE NOTE: Children under 5 and Adults over 90 are not covered by AIDKA Insurance, therefore enter the pit area at their own, or parent/guardians' risk. These persons will need to sign in, sign a waiver and wear a wrist band that shows they have done so, before entry to the pit area.
	Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is not permitted in the PIT AREA or RED ZONE at any time. Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking areas; the location of these areas will be announced at drivers brief.
	Alcohol is NOT TO BE CONSUMED or located in the pit area at any time. Your wrist band will be removed if you purchase or drink alcohol during the race meeting each day. You will need to get another wrist band for the next day of racing.

Pit Parking	Pits will open from Thursday 10:00am for those that will be pitting out of trailers.					
	All trailers MUST be in the pits No Later than 9am Friday. Absolutely No Exceptions.					
	The following criteria should be considered: Trailers are not to be removed at the end of each day/night and put back in the next day. 					
	 If you do need to remove it for any reason, please see Gary Duff, Tony Gibb or Peter Reichstein for assistance to get it out. 					
	• Trailers/transport vehicles only to remain in the pits, all tow-vehicles are to be removed.					
	 Toyhaulers/vans camping in the red zone must turn off and disconnect gas bottles until end of racing each day 					
	 All trailers will be parked with the assistant 	• All trailers will be parked with the assistance of Pit Marshals whose directions will be final.				
	 Vehicles are not permitted in the pit area whilst racing is in progress, until the conclusion of racing on the last day. 					
	 If you wish to be located near another competitor, please email our nomination secretary. 					
	 While every effort will be made to satisfy requests, no guarantees can be made, as your request may not be achievable. 					
	Shade tents are permitted provided they are no larger than 3mx3m per kart nominated, as this is a standard pit bay size.

Facilities- Camping Camping with vans, tents and caravans will be available at the track when other accommodation in town is booked up. Vans can be delivered onsite during the week leading up to the titles- members will be on site to help supervise.

Showers: A large shower block has been hired to supplement on-site hot showers (price included in camping fee)

NOTE: due to recent Murray River Flood conditions, most accommodation has been severely impacted and may not be available. Program has been adjusted to help drivers who may need to travel each day due to accommodation problems.

Nominal camping fee of \$100 per site for the duration of the titles event payable via AIDKA app (under the Merchandise option).

Enter the number of camping sites you require under the Merchandise Section in the Camping Sites option. Payment is required at the time. Camping sites may be booked up to an including Friday 5th April 2023.

Please note, any camping in pit enclosure must be organised prior to the event as pits will be locked from Friday morning to end of racing on Sunday.

No power is available for campers. Please turn your generators off approx. 11pm please.
