 Race direction will change each round.

 Chief Steward has the right to decrease laps due to time restraints or move program forward.

 Track graded as necessary.

Class Requirements: A minimum of 8 genuine nominations constitutes a class as per 2023 AIDKA Rule Book. Only the first **80 legitimate nominations** per class will be accepted.

 Demonstration class may run, depending on nominations in other classes. Only if time permits. (Only the first 20 nominations will be accepted)
 Rookies will run on Sunday only if time permits.
 There is no guarantee to how many heats will be run as this class is non competitive.
 Rookies nomination fee \$20 for Sunday.
 Rookies nominations will be received via a separate event on the AIDKA App.
 Drivers will receive participation awards.
 Nominations close same day and time as AIDKA Title nominations or prior if maximum 20 Rookies is reached.
 Nominate via the AIDKA App
 Rookie nominations to be placed via a separate event on the AIDKA App.





CLOSE: Monday 18th September 2023 at 9pm (ACST). Individual class nominations may close earlier if 80 legitimate entries are received. No late nominations will be accepted. The AIDKA App is the only acceptable way to nominate. **Nomination Fees:** Seniors \$125 Juniors \$125 Rookies \$ 20 Full payment must accompany nomination. Please note: No Midgets will be demonstrating at this event. **Presentation Dinner:** Meals - \$30 Roast meal & dessert Meals payable with nominations via the AIDKA App. Pre-booked tickets only. Meals served from 6.00pm provided by Bordertown Netball Clubs. Meal tickets can be purchased on the AIDKA App: Trophy presentation as soon as practical after 7pm. Strictly no BYO. Strictly no GLASS on site. Venue: Tatiara Council Town Hall - (1km from track) Dress code: Casual presentations held inside town hall As per Rules 1 and 2, Appendix A of the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book. Please ensure you **Entrant Eligibility:** read and understand the requirements prior to nominating. Nominations shall only be accepted as per the prospectus with any requested information and the appropriate fees being paid in full. To fulfill nomination requirements full payment and copy of the drivers logbook (pages which list the race meetings attended) must be received by AIDKA at the time of nominating. If insufficient meetings attended during the current year please provide a copy of last years log book also. Full payment must accompany the nomination via the AIDKA App for your nominations to **Payment Method:** be accepted. Confirmation of your nomination will be posted on AIDKA app. **Refund Policy Cancellation by Entrant** As per Appendix A Rule 2 - Any nomination cancelled before close of nomination will incur a 50% fee. Cancellations after closing will result in a loss of full nomination fee. The only exception are cancellations due to a valid medical reason (certificate required) these cancellations will receive a full refund. **Event Cancellation** As per Appendix A Rule 6c **Race Numbers:** As per 2023 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing number in a class: Driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number (has had a licence for the longest period of time) has first preference for kart number. Current Australian and State Title Plates are permitted to be used. Once AIDKA Secretary has checked and confirmed all nominations, those that need to change race numbers will be notified via the AIDKA App. **Driver Registration:** To be held at the track on Thurs 26th Oct, 8am to 11am. At sign-in, you will be issued with a wristband, you will sign the indemnity sheet and have your logbook filled in. You will require an engine seal for the engine you will be running. If you require an additional seal for your spare motor, these will be available from appointed official during the meeting. Any engine used must be presented with the seal still attached for the engine measuring



	at the conclusion of the race meeting.		
	You will also require a chassis seal, regardless if your chassis has a number stamped		
	into it. The chassis seal is to be fitted to the chassis at the base of the steering column		
	Seals must be fitted prior to the first heat of racing.		
Rookies Sign In:	To be held at the track on Sun 29 th Oct 7.30am to 8am.		
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Event Programs:	Each driver will receive a complimentary program with their nomination. Additional programs will be available to purchase from the canteen.		
Points:	AIDKA 23 Point System.		
	Quick Grid to be used to calculate grid draw and placings.		
Transponders:	Orbits timing software to be used in conjunction with karting compatible transponders. Transponders are compulsory as per the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book. TRANSPONDERS ARE COMPULSORY FOR PRACTICE so that the system can be checked.		
Trophies:	Trophies and AIDKA Australian Title number plates will be awarded to the first three place winners in each class.		
	Sashes will be awarded to drivers placed 4 th to 6 th only in over-subscribed classes (more than 20 nominations with split fields).		
	AIDKA Junior Participation Award will be presented to all non-place getting Junior Light & Junior Heavy drivers.		
Rules:	As per the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book.		
Drugs and Alcohol:	Drug and alcohol testing may be carried out at random throughout Australian Dirt Kart Title event on any given day or time, as per AIDKA 2023 Rule Book.		
Scales:	Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day as per 2023 AIDKA Rule Book. Scales are available for drivers to set up their weights from Thursday prior to event.		
	Weights may be re-checked before and/or after any races throughout the event.		
Fuel Testing:	As per Rule 25 to 25.3 of the 2023 AIDKA Rule Book		
Scrutineering:	Self scrutineering applies. Qualified scrutineers will spot check karts throughout the event.		
	Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart can participate in any further racing.		
	Any issue (ie: unsafe kart/missing seal) that is not rectified prior to a race commencing, may result in the offending kart being removed from the out grid.		
	Any kart missing either an engine or chassis seal that is not rectified may be excluded from the race meeting.		
	If you have any questions regarding technical requirements, you can ask an official who will direct you to the appropriate person.		
	Only AIDKA licensed persons are permitted in the pit bay area. All other persons/spectators must purchase a Casual Pit Pass online, wear a wrist band & wear enclosed shoes before entering the pit area.		
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If the weekend wrist band is removed prior to the end of the State Title Event, a new Pit Pass must be purchased.



	Please Note – NOT PERMITTED in the Pit Area during the designated racing times are – • Fires, camp fires, stoves, gas fridges etc • Pets or animals
	 Alcohol consumption Please note NOT PERMITTED in the Pit Area ANY TIME DURING THE EVENT is : Smoking (including e-cigarettes)
	Designated areas will be allocated for the above where possible. Location of these areas will be shown in the program.
	WRIST BANDS AND ENCLOSED FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILST IN THE DESIGNATED PIT AREA.
	Please Note - Children under 5 and adults over 90 are not covered by AIDKA Insurance, therefore entry to the pit area is at their own, or parent/guardian's risk. Under 5's and over 90's will need to register, sign a waiver and wear a wrist band that shows they have done so before entry to the pit area.
Pit Parking:	Pits will open from Wed 12noon, all trailers MUST be in the pits NO Later than 10pm Wed.
	If you are unable to pit on Wednesday, bookings are essential to pit park on Thursday. Please email membership@tatiarakartingclub.net.au. You will be pitted at the closest convenient pit bay, there will be no priority pitting on Thursday. No bays will be held. The following criteria should be considered:
	• Trailers are not to be removed at the end of each day/night and put back in the next day.
	• Once your trailer has entered the pits, it's in for the event duration. If you need to remove a trailer for any reason, please see Tatiara Karting Club President or Vice President for assistance. Please understand, any trailers removed over night and wanting to return will be repositioned closest to the entry gate.
	There will be no security on duty overnight.
	• Trailers only to remain in the pits, all vehicles are to be removed.
	• All trailers will be parked with the assistance of Pit Marshals whose directions will be
	final.
	 Vehicles are not permitted in the pit area while racing is in progress and are not permitted until the conclusion of racing on the last day.
	 If you wish to be located/pitted near another competitor, you must arrive together. Spaces will not be held.
	• While every effort will be made to satisfy requests, no guarantees can be made, as your request may not be achievable.
	 No additional pit space will be allocated for camping within your trailer.
