## Clearly explain the new rule/changes requested.

Holographic &/or reflective numbers/nassau panels/side pods/number plate backgrounds can reflect with the sun interfering with the ability of officials from seeing the kart numbers whilst on track. Holographic &/or reflective number plates are also hard to see when racing under lights.

Despite the use of transponders, stewards & tower staff still need to be able to clearly read kart numbers without interference.

## What situation/event/scenario has created this proposed rule change

Inability for a steward & tower staff to be able to correctly read a kart number due to reflection from the sun on kart with holographic/reflective numbers/stickers. Same situation has happened when racing under lights.
