## PROSPECTUS

**Hosted by:** Busselton Dirt Kart Club

**Address:** Gordon Road, Busselton, WA, 6280

**Date:** 7<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> November 2025

**Track Specification:** 475 metres

**Racing Format:** 4 Heats and a final. Highest Points to the front for final.

All points accumulated to decide placings (8 lap heats and 8 lap final).

Race direction – Alternate each Heat and final at Chief Stewards discretion.

*Chief Steward has the right to decrease laps due to time constraints or move the program forward.*

### Classes available for nomination:

**Midget:** *Demonstration / Non-competitive class only. See notes under "Nominations".*

**Rookies:** *Demonstration / Non-competitive class only. See notes under "Nominations".*

**Jnr Grade:** Junior Light Junior Heavy

**C Grade:** KT Light KT Medium KT Heavy Statesman

**B Grade:** 125 Light 125 Medium 125 Heavy 100 Open

**A Grade:** KT Twin 200 Open Outlaw

**\*\*Please note that half the classes will race Heats 1-3 Friday and the remaining classes will race Heats 1-3 Saturday, with all classes racing Heat 4 and final on Sunday\*\***

**Class requirements:** As per 2025 AIDKA Rule book (Appendix A Rule 5)  
Each competitive class will be capped at 40 nominations.

**Nominations:** Competitors to nominate via the AIDKA App. Payment must accompany nomination.  
This is the ONLY way to nominate, and NO late nominations will be accepted.

**Nominations Open:** 28<sup>th</sup> August 2025

**Nominations Close:** 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025

Rookies and Midgets will be capped at 20 nominations and will have their own event via the AIDKA App.

Rookie and Midget nominations will close same day as competitive nominations *or earlier* if maximum number of 20 nominations is reached prior. Rookies will run on Saturday only as time permits. The number of heats cannot be guaranteed. Midgets will run on Sunday only as time permits. The number of heats cannot be guaranteed.

Rookies and Midgets will receive a Driver Participation Award.

**Nomination Fees:** Senior & Juniors \$150 per class  
Rookies and Midgets \$30

**Entrant Eligibility:** As per Appendix A, Rules 1 & 2 in 2025 AIDKA Rule book. Please make sure you understand the requirements prior to nominating. Drivers will need to provide a copy of their logbook (pages with the list of race meetings attended). This may mean you'll need to provide a copy of last year's logbook too. Any incorrect nominations (i.e. not meeting qualification criteria or failing to supply proof of qualification) will result in the nomination being withheld and will not be visible on the nomination listing until proof is received. This means at this stage position in the class entry will not be held (each class is capped at 40 nominations) if qualification is not met / proven by the close of nominations for this event or the class reaches capacity you will receive a refund as per appendix A, Rule 2.

**Refund Policy:** Cancellation by Driver: As per Appendix A, Rule 2.  
Event cancellation: As per Appendix A Rule 6c

**Kart/Race Numbers:** As per 2025 AIDKA Rule Book, if one or more entrants nominate with the same racing number in a class then the Driver with the lowest AIDKA licence number has first preference for kart number.  
Current Australian and State Title Plates are permitted to be used.  
Once the AIDKA Secretary has checked and confirmed all nominations, those that need to change race numbers will be notified via the AIDKA App. Please make sure your email address is correct too.

**Driver Registration:** Will be held outside the nomination shed on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> of November from 4pm to 8pm, Friday 7<sup>th</sup> November 7am – 8am, Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> November 7am – 8am (including Rookies) and Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> November 7:15am – 7:30am for Midgets.

At Sign-In you will need to show your 'live' AIDKA licence. You will be issued with a wristband, sign the Indemnity sheet, and have your logbook filled in. At this point you will also receive a complimentary program of the event. Engine and Chassis seals will also be issued at this point.

**Pit Crew Registration:** Will be held outside the nominations shed on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> of November from 4pm - 8pm. Outside of these times there will be a manned booth at the Pit Gate entrance. Licenced Pit Crew will be required to show their digital AIDKA licence and present their logbook for sign-in. They will then receive a wristband for the entire event.

## EVENT DETAILS

<b>Rules:</b>	<b>As per 2025 AIDKA Rule Book.</b>
<b>Points:</b>	AIDKA 23-point system will be used with QuickGrid calculating grid draws and eventual placings.
<b>Transponders:</b>	Orbits Timing Software (MyLaps) will be used in conjunction with karting compatible transponders. Transponders are <b><u>compulsory</u></b> and <b><u>must be attached prior to practice</u></b> so that the system can be checked and make sure your transponder is working correctly.
<b>Trophies:</b>	Trophies and WA Title plates will be awarded to the first three place getters in each class. Sashes will be awarded to drivers placed 4 <sup>th</sup> to 6 <sup>th</sup> in all classes.
<b>Drugs &amp; Alcohol:</b>	Drug and Alcohol testing may occur at this event. Drivers, Officials and Pit Crew are chosen at random throughout the event on any given day or time.
<b>Scales:</b>	Competitors must weigh to the scales of the day. Our scales are professionally calibrated yearly.
<b>Fuel Testing:</b>	As per Rule 24 – Rule 25.3 of the 2025 AIDKA Rule Book.
<b>Scrutineering:</b>	<p>Self-Scrutineering will be conducted at this event. Accredited Scrutineers will also be conducting random spot checks throughout the event.</p> <p>Any items deemed unsafe will be required to be rectified before the kart participate in any further racing.</p> <p>Any issue that is not rectified prior to a race commencing, may result in the offending kart being removed from the Out Grid.</p> <p>Any kart missing either an engine or chassis seal that is not rectified, may be excluded from the race meeting.</p>
<b>Engine/Chassis Seals:</b>	<p>At Driver Registration, drivers will be issued with a Chassis seal and engine seal for the engine they are running. If they require an additional seal for spare motor, these will be available upon request from an appointed Official during the meeting.</p> <p>If you are fortunate enough to be asked to present to the Engine Measuring team at the conclusion of the event, all engines used during the meeting (for that class) must be presented with seal still attached.</p> <p>As per Appendix A, Rule 15, Engine seals are to be fitted prior to first race. Most competitors don't attach their engine seals until after Practice. Please refer to Appendix F with regards to fitting of Engine seals.</p>
<b>Pit Area Access:</b>	<p><b>Must have a Title issued wrist band and enclosed shoes to enter the Pit Area.</b></p> <p>If you are an AIDKA <u>licence holder</u> you will need to show your AIDKA licence and logbook to receive a wrist band and sign the indemnity form.</p> <p>If <u>unlicensed</u>; the person will need to apply for a casual pit pass online (\$10/day) via the AIDKA App or scan the QR Code which will be available to scan throughout the public areas in our venue. Unlicensed Pit Crew will still need to receive a wristband and sign the indemnity form.</p> <p>We encourage people to have this done prior to the event to keep the 'flow of traffic' running smoothly for our volunteers.</p> <p>1-Day Pit Pass = \$10 2-Day Pit Pass = \$20 3-Day Pit Pass = \$30</p> <p>If wristbands are removed prior to end of Title event, a new Pit Pass/wrist band must be purchased.</p>

Please note that Children under the age of 5 yrs and Adults over the age of 90 yrs are not covered by AIDKA Insurance. These people may enter our pit area at their own risk. They are still required to sign-in, wear a wrist band and sign the indemnity form acknowledging they are not covered by insurance.

**Pit Bay Setup:** Pits will be open for trailer, kart and equipment drop off Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> of November 2pm – 8pm and then reopen early Friday & Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> November 6am – 7am. We encourage competitors to arrive Thursday if possible but appreciate people still need to work and travel. You will be directed with the assistance of a Pit Marshall.

**Trailer Parking:** Trailers will be parked with the assistance of Pit Marshalls. Once your trailer is parked in the pit area, it will be there for the duration of the event. All vehicles are to be removed from the Pit Area. Please email all Trailer measurements and requests to [bdkcwa.title@gmail.com](mailto:bdkcwa.title@gmail.com).

Please note that not all trailers will be allowed in the pits due to space constraints. Even if you do submit Trailer requirements you may not be able to have your trailer in the Pits. Please do not complain to the Club or the organisers, all requests will be reviewed at the time of entry closure. Please if you can work on a buddy system with your mates or Teams. We would like to see as a minimum 3-4 Karts per trailer.

**There will be no Vehicles in the Pits during the event, this includes Vans / Trucks / Pantech's. No one will be allowed to pit out a vehicle.**

If you wish to remove your kart/s and equipment at the completion of each day, you may do so, however cars and trailers will not be permitted into the pits at the completion of racing Friday & Saturday, you will need take your kart out on its trolley or alternative method.

BKC will be offering allocated pit space for those who request it. Pit Bays will be allocated based upon 2 karts per 3mtr x 3mtr and 4 karts per 6mtr x 3mtr shelter. Larger areas will be by consideration with the club. This will be determined once nominations close.

Please ensure that your application is in before 27<sup>th</sup> October as no spaces will be allocated after this date.

A pit parking map and time allocation will be released prior to drop off day and should be strictly adhered to, to ensure all competitors and equipment will fit within the allocated areas. Remember email your pit requirements to [bdkcwa.title@gmail.com](mailto:bdkcwa.title@gmail.com) prior to entries closing.

**Pit Security:** Any equipment left at the track overnight is done so at your own risk.
